Youth Scholarship Program Requirements

The Living Word Christian Ministries is committed to awarding college scholarship funds to assist students in the amount of \$1,000 per qualified applicants. And it is our desire to recognize academic excellence and service rendered in the church and in the community. Deadline for the submission is May 16th of each year no later than 6:00pm. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

- () Official transcript from your current school indicating a “B” grade average.
- () Letter of Recommendation from a community leader or a teacher.
- () Three hundred (300) word essay addressing, “The Legacy you would like to leave to your Family and Community.” All essays must be typed and double-spaced, using 12pt. font. This completed document should be included in your application package and delivered by mail to The Living Word Christian Ministries, Inc. 9925 Bunker Hill Road, Waldorf, MD 20603, or emailed to Scholarship Administrator at scholarship@tlwcm.org or in person at the church, no later than May 16th no later than 6:pm.
- () Student applicant cannot be older than 22 years of age at the time of application.
- () Applicant must be enrolled in high school or registered in college.
- () Applicant must be an active partner in good standing of The Living Word Christian Ministries for one year with regular attendance. This is applicable only to those students in high school.
- () Applicant must have participated and volunteered in an area of ministry for one year. This must be verified by a letter from a Director or Administrator.

Although not limited to this list, the following qualifies as areas of participation.

Children’s Church
Junior Deacon / Deaconess
Audio Ministry / Fellowship and Integration
Evangelism, Outreach
Youth leadership role

- () Applicant must provide an acceptance letter from the College that they plan to attend.
- () In the even the applicant is a full time college student, they are required to participate in a community outreach program for a period of 30 hours for that school year. The applicant is required to provide a verification letter from a leader of that organization indicating the hours and type of service rendered. The organization must be a nonprofit organization.
- () Applicant must commit to being present on Scholarship Sunday for presentation. If the amount of approved applicants exceeds the amount reserved because there are several applicants qualified, the Board of Directors will divide the funds equally.
